AFSCME By the Numbers

- >Over 1.4 million members
- **≥**3,400 locals and 58 councils
- > "Architects to Zookeepers"





Public Plans by the Numbers

- > 85 percent of public sector covered by DB
- ➤ About 6,000 public retirement systems in U.S. hold \$4.5 trillion
- ➤ 14 million active participants and 10 million retirees and beneficiaries






Public Sector Collective Bargaining


- > Not covered by National Labor Relations Act
- > Pensions typically not a mandatory bargaining subject
- > Rights established via state and local law
- **➤** No PBGC coverage













Public Pension Costs are Manageable

- > The Sustainability of State and Local Government Pensions: A Public Finance Approach
 - No imminent crisis
 - Historically operated short of full prefunding
 - Benefit payments are at peak levels
